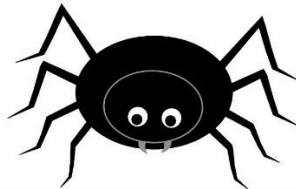

Afterschool Reminders

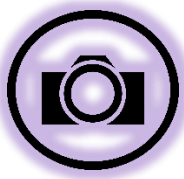
- ➔ If your child is going to be absent from EDCC for any reason, please notify us by phone or email as the school office does not tell us if your child will not be at school for that day.

- ➔ If someone not on your emergency card is picking up your child, they will need to show ID if it is their first time picking up, so we can ensure your child's safety!

Safe Trick-Or-Treating Practices

Kids look forward to Halloween for many reasons. They like the dressing up in costumes, but they mostly like it for the candy and treats! For extra fun and excitement this year mom and dad should get into Halloween just as much as their kids do. If you are taking your kids out for the night, dress up as well! Think about it. Make your child's Halloween a memorable holiday, so they'll have precious memories that last a lifetime!

Be sure to remember:

- ➔ Children should always go out trick or treating accompanied by a responsible adult.
- ➔ Instruct children not to eat any treats until they bring them home to be examined by an adult.
- ➔ While trick-or-treating, instruct children never to go into the home of a stranger or get into their car. Explain why this is not a good idea and what to do if someone unfamiliar approaches them and tries to talk to them.
- ➔ Make sure children carry a flashlight, glow stick, or has reflective tape on their costume to make them more visible to cars.
