## EDCC Gives Back



Our Vice President, Marin McElhany-D'Acquisto found out about a wonderful company called BOMBAS a few years ago, which makes very cool socks.

Did you know that socks are the #1 most requested item in homeless shelters?

Bombas means "bumblebee" in Latin, and their slogan is "bee better." Bombas chose bees as they live in hives and work together to make their world a better place. Albeit small, their combined actions have a big impact in the world. When you roll down the top of the sock, you can see the logo printed there. They did this as a reminder that you helped someone with your purchase. And that little improvements can add up to make a big difference. How cool is that?

Bombas donates one pair of their socks for every pair that they sell. Over 11 million pairs of socks have been donated to people in need!
