## EDCC SICKNESS POLICY

It is that time of the year again when germs are going around. Please help our teachers and students stay healthy. Should your child become ill at school, you will be called to make immediate arrangements to pick up your child. EDCC cannot by law offer service to a child who is ill. Please contact the center if your child has been picked up from school and will not be coming to EDCC so we are not searching for them afterschool. If your child does not attend school for any reason then your child may not attend EDCC for that day. If your child exhibits any of the symptoms listed below during our care, we will call and ask you to pick up your child. A sick child must be picked up immediately upon notification from EDCC. For the protection of all children, your child must be kept home if they exhibit any of the following symptoms:

- \*fever over 100 degrees
- \*diarrhea, nausea, vomiting
- \*head lice and/or nits, scabies, mites
- \*any contagious ailment
- \*skin rash unless diagnose as non-infectious by physician
- \*nasal, eye or ear discharge with color
